THE BASICS OF CO-OPS

A co-op is founded and organized by people who want goods or services provided to them through a democratically-controlled enterprise. It is owned by the people who support the business, use it, and invest equity into it. Owners invest in the business to provide capital (i.e., equity) for strong, efficient operation. Co-ops can be many kinds of businesses. Belfast Community Co-op is a retail grocery store food co-op.

Belfast Community Co-op is a member of NCG. National Co+op Grocers (NCG) is a business services cooperative for retail food co-ops located throughout the United States. Representing 150+ food co-ops operating over 220 stores across the country serving over 1.3 million consumer-owners. NCG provides the capacity of a chain while maintaining the autonomy of each individual co-op. As a member of this national food Co-op we can strengthen purchasing power, and offer more value to our co-op shoppers.

Shopping Bulk

When the Co-op buys in bulk quantities, the volume discount is passed down to shoppers. You can bring your own containers and you can buy as little or as much as you need!

Shopping from the bulk aisle also makes it more affordable to try rare and premium spices that you only need a little of - like cardamom or whole nutmeg. Coffee, grains, herbs & spices; even liquids like maple syrup, honey, soaps and vinegars are some of the items you can buy in bulk.

Pre-Order Discount

Belfast Community Co-op owners have the benefit of being able to pre-order regularly stocked items, orders are by the case or supplier pack size at 15% off*. All shoppers can pre-order but only owners receive the discount! No additional discounts apply on preorders. Find out more at Customer Service.

CORE

Our CORE program is designed to make local, organic, & wholesome foods more affordable for income restricted households. CORE is



available for those owners who currently receive economic assistance through federal or state programs. Upon acceptance into the CORE program, owners receive an extended equity payment schedule and a 10% discount on most of our products.* This discount will be applied in addition to Co+op Deals sales, but cannot be combined with any other discounts. FOOD ACCESS PROGRAMS

We are proud to support these programs for our shoppers:

SNAP/EBT

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) provides a monthly benefit to help low-income households purchase nutritious food. Eligibility for SNAP is based on income, assets, expenses and household size. *maine.gov/dhhs*





WIC

We're honored to be the first food co-op in Maine to offer WIC! The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children is better known as the WIC Program. Pregnant, postpartum, and chestfeeding people, guardians, and infants & children up to age five are eligible. Participants must live in Maine. WIC food benefits are available based on income


guidelines and health status. WIC participants use an eWIC card to purchase specific wholesome foods each month. WIC also provides iron-fortified infant formula. *maine.gov/WIC*.
